A number of women from our different Self Help Groups (SHGs) have lost their livelihood due to lockdown. But they took up the cause and began stitching cotton masks as an additional source of income for their families.

Close to **1,70,000 lakhs face masks** have stitched as organized by our offices in Gujarat. The masks have been distributed to all sections of the public including police personnel, vegetable vendors, Aanagawadi workers, and others who are providing public services of essentials.
